From the desk of the Principal

We need a new playground!!

An update from the P&C Fundraising Sub-Committee:

Upgrading our school playground has long been on the agenda for consecutive P&C committees over the years. In the past, schools have had assistance for playground maintenance and/or refurbishment from local council or the NSW Dep of Education. However, these bodies relinquished responsibility for school playgrounds in 1999, and now, all responsibility for playgrounds rest with the school community.

In 2015, the P&C worked with a local company, Creative Recreation Solutions (CRS) to develop some concept designs for brand new, safe, modern play equipment. Our wonderful new playground has a price tag of **\$60,000**.





In order to try and finance this, we have submitted three grant applications over the last 12-18 months to various funding programs including Community Building Partnerships Grants (NSW Govt), IMB Community Grants and Clubs Grants (through Wollongong City Council). All have been unsuccessful. Whilst we have several other plans up our sleeve, after discussions with other potential community funders and members of the P&C, our own fundraising target of **\$60,000** has been agreed upon with which to refurbish our school playground.

The playground is heavily used by all of our students, all of our OOSH families; it is old and in desperate need of an upgrade. Learning through play is one of the fundamental elements in a child's development. Being able to provide an area where this need is met in such an interactive way will ensure our children continue to grow in their self-confidence, social skills and provide them with the essential decision making opportunities they require in today's society.

So how are we going to raise \$60,000?

We are planning to launch a 'Go Fund Me' fundraising campaign in 2017 to help reach our target (stay tuned). We intend to apply to Wests Illawarra for funding support. But to kick it all off, we are holding a raffle for a Queensland holiday! One book of 20 tickets per family will be sent home with the eldest child towards the end of Term 3. The raffle will be drawn at the Twilight Festival at the end of Term 4.

We hope everyone will be enthusiastic about this wonderful holiday prize, and get behind all the future initiatives to help us reach our target! By the way, although the prize is for '2 adults, 2 children', we checked, and the room CAN accommodate a third child (the winner will need to negotiate this at a small extra cost if necessary).
