Bookings are made online through our **My Family Lounge app**. Please follow instructions as set out in the "bookings instructions" guide.

YOU MUST ALSO COMPLETE AND RETURN ATTACHED BOOKINGS PERMISSION FORM. This is a regulation requirement and bookings will not be accepted until these forms are returned. Returns via email & in person are accepted.

PROCEDURES & CONDITIONS FOR VACATION CARE

- Cancellations of any booked days are permitted up to **MONDAY 31ST DEC.**
- All fees **WILL APPLY** to any bookings after Monday 31st Dec, including new bookings made after this date.
- All children must wear clothing with sleeves as well as appropriate clothing for the activity and weather.
- By booking online you are accepting the conditions set out here for this vacation care as well as accepting all responsibilities and fees as set out in our fees policy.
- Vacation care bookings are casual bookings and are charged per day and include all fees set out in the vacation care program.
- **Booking errors** – If you make an incorrect booking, first you must change the incorrect booking to "absent" through the app, and then call the service immediately for support 42272515. Errors made during our closed period must be emailed. You will be charged for any incorrect bookings if you do not contact us on the same day as making the booking.
- **Absences** – You must notify the service of all absences on booked days as soon as possible. All fees apply on absences. You can notify using the MFL app.
- **Waiting lists** – we no longer have waitlists. Available spaces are viewed using the MFL app. You can contact the service on 42272515 to check availability the afternoon before or the morning of the day you need care in case there are last minute absences.
- **Educator to child ratios** – Expected ratios may change for activities based on risk, type of activity & location. Expected ratios are communicated for each activity on the program.

ACTIVITIES PROGRAM:
