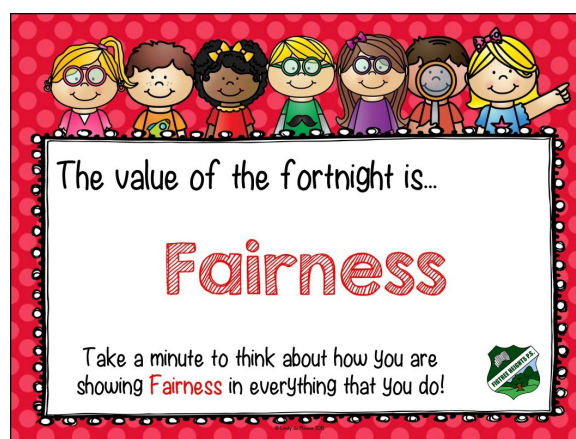

Updated Covid-19 Advice

As of this morning we have received further updated advice in regards to Covid-19 and schools. Some new developments are:

- Students who are sent home, or kept home from school with flu like symptoms are required to be tested. They may return to school when they receive a negative result (to be sighted by the school) and no longer have any symptoms.
- Unfortunately choir is no longer able to run.
- Students are to stay in their relevant year or stage group for learning activities where possible. We will need to determine what this means for future planned enrichment activities.

What has not changed is that non-essential adults, including parents, are not to enter the school grounds. Nor has the request that unwell students stay at home. However, we still have children coming to school who are sick and parents who walk their children to hang up their bags. Please be mindful of our students who have vulnerable health concerns and we ask that you respect these guidelines. Many of our classes took part in lessons on cyber safety in the Life Education van. As a result much discussion has been had on various social media sites and it has come to the attention of staff that many of our students have TikTok accounts that are not set at high levels of privacy. As well as this, some groups of students have posted themselves in their school uniform and on school grounds after school hours. Neither being ideal, as students are not to be on school grounds out of school hours, but more troubling is that recognisable uniforms or locations are constantly warned against by those who investigate the darker side of social media and inappropriate interactions with minors.

Please take the time to check on your child's social media accounts and privacy settings, as well as discussing the dangers of such posts. This will support what we are telling them at school and help them keep themselves safe.

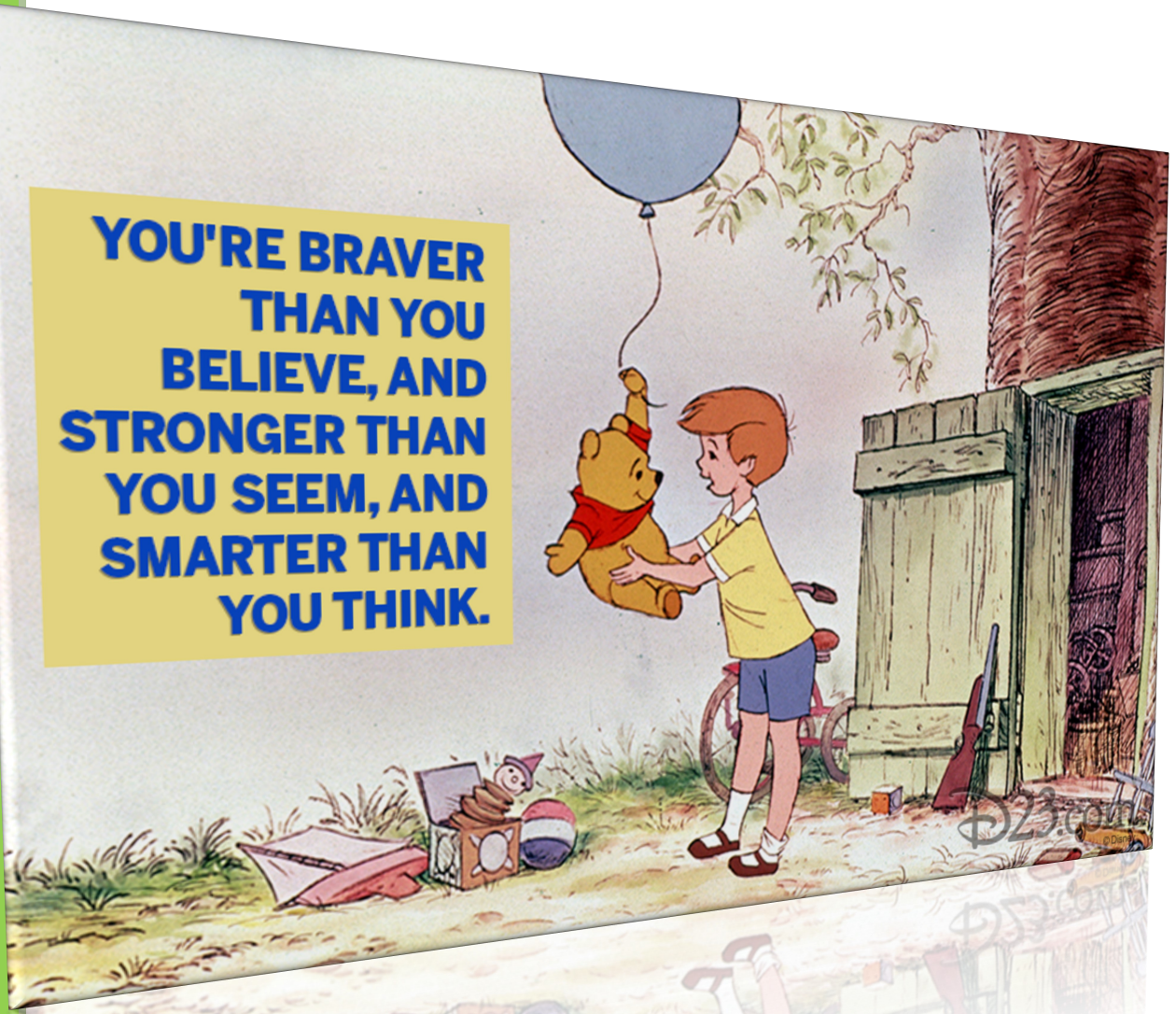
