

Swimming Carnival

Thank you to all the parents who have volunteered to do a job at our carnival, we will see you at the pool nice and early! Students will be meeting under our small COLA at 8:30am to get the bus at 8:40am, hopefully with us ready to start the first race at 9:10am. All volunteers will need to be signed in on our sheet as we are required to provide the pool with a list of all adults attending the day. Ms Wyman or myself will be stationed near the entry to the pool with the sign on sheet. Unfortunately if you are not a volunteer (who's name is on the sheet) you will be unable to attend the carnival.

A good question was asked about our carnival that I thought I would share in case you were wondering the same thing.

Q: Can I transport my own child rather than pay \$6?

A: The \$6 is actually to assist pay for the bus, the pool hire and equipment hire. The actual cost is already subsidised by the school so we can make it as affordable as we can. The cost is always worked out based on the number of students we have, meaning if not all contribute then we will have to increase the cost to help cover the expenses. Therefore, even if parents provide transport the cost of attending is still \$6 per student. We do prefer they travel with us so we know they will be there when we arrive (in case we are running late) and that they will be leaving when we do (in case the person picking is running late). Should you need financial assistance for this, or any other school event, please contact the office and they will provide you with a Student Assistance form. It is a very easy process.

We still have a number of families who are yet to pay, so please send this in as soon as possible as we will have invoices to sort out soon.

Drop Off and Pick Up Changes

Now that everyone is settling into school routines we are back to all students being dropped off and picked up at the gate rather than being escorted in, regardless of their grade.

While our Kindergarten students are being dismissed at 2:30pm they will all be escorted to the front gate on St Georges Ave.

Please remember all visitors to our school must enter via the front office (except for Parent Information Meetings) where you will need to sign in using a QR code for the Health Department, our sign in book and Covid form. If you need to speak to a teacher definitely feel free to make an appointment (or we can arrange a phone call) but we ask that you don't take yourself straight to your child's class-room before or after school as we need a record of all adults on site.

Parent Information Sessions



If you would like to volunteer in the canteen please complete the form attached to the newsletter.




Place all your canteen orders online with Flexischools

Dear Parents and Carers,

The P&C Canteen Committee are asking for volunteers to help in our canteen. The roster will commence from February 2021 and will run until December 2021.

The canteen hours are as follows:

Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00am to 12:00pm (approx)

These canteen opening times are subject to sufficient volunteers to enable the roster to be filled.

No experience is necessary for canteen duty. Just a day or two a term of your time is needed to deliver this service to our children. Mums, dads, carers, aunts, uncles and grandparents are most welcome to volunteer, we just need you to complete 100 points of identification through the school office.

The more volunteers we have the less frequent your roster days will be, so please consider adding one canteen day a month to your calendar. Without parent help it would be impossible to give our children this service.

If it is difficult for you to commit yourself on a regular basis, please consider; volunteering as an emergency contact for the odd day that needs filling, or volunteering an hour to help out on our busiest day, Friday. You can also nominate to be included in our canteen volunteers closed group on Facebook. This will allow you to see when we are short of volunteers and fill in as you are able.
