Covid Update

You may have heard through the media that parents are permitted back on school grounds, which is the start of a welcomed return to normality. What they forgot to mention is that when you enter school grounds, even to walk your child to class, you're still required to first sign in via the QR code to maintain accurate records for tracing purposes. Social distancing, of 1.5m, between adults who do not reside together is necessary and anyone who is feeling unwell is not to enter the school at all. Please be considerate of staff and do not put them in the position of having to ask you to follow guidelines as we don't have a designated 'Covid Marshal'.

Currently we are able to have 50 adults on site in general circumstances. As we do not have staggered dismissal times, and our two covered areas are not large enough to accommodate social distancing on the necessary scale, we will continue with pick up being at the gate. We ask that if drop off is also working for you and your child in the current format, that you continue to do so outside the school. If escorting your child in, then please do this quickly (still use the QR code) to limit the number of adults we have on site. Should you be remaining on site for any given reason (eg canteen or classroom helper) then please sign our visitors' book at the office as well as using the QR code. If we get further advice to the contrary of any of the above we will communicate amended procedures next week.

For specific events the organiser is required to submit a Covid-19 Safety Plan. One aspect of this plan is to *Ensure the number of people in a facility does not exceed one person per 2 square metres of publicly accessible space.* We will have to determine what this means for our school venue sites for any upcoming events and will definitely keep you posted. For the time being our notes (that were already prepared) will still state that there won't be spectators, but if we can work a way around having a given number of parents we will let you know...as an audience always makes an event far more exciting!
