### Covid Update

We have managed to get some clarification on signing in requirements when you visit our school. If you are just walking your child in, you no longer need to sign in even with the QR code. However, if you are staying to help with canteen or in a classroom, then you will have to sign in at the office and use the QR code.

Social distancing, of 1.5m, between adults not residing together is still necessary and anyone who is feeling unwell is not to enter the school at all. Please continue to be considerate of staff and do not put them in the position where they have to ask you to follow such guidelines. We do not have a designated 'Covid Marshal'.

As mentioned last week, we will continue with pick up as is, since we do not have staggered dismissal times, and our two covered areas are not large enough for us to accommodate social distancing on the necessary scale.

### Year 6 to Year 7 Forms

Year 6 students will be bringing home their *Moving into Year 7 in a NSW Government school in 2022* forms today. These forms were late in arriving at the school due to postage delays but are meant to be due back this Friday. Thank you for returning these as soon as possible.

### Need to Talk to a Teacher?

If you have a question or concern your child's teacher is generally the best person for you to talk to. However, the best way to make contact with them is via phoning or emailing the school. This way we can pass the message on for you, or similarly let you know if there will be a delay in the return call if the teacher is absent or attending professional learning. As teachers are busy during the day teaching, covering duty and attending meetings, they do not check their emails or Seesaw messages regularly throughout the day, nor may they be able to make return contact immediately. Generally staff will try to get back to you as soon as we can, but please allow up to two days as some days are more hectic than others!

### Tell Them From Me Surveys

Early next term, our school is taking part in the *Tell Them From Me* student survey (run by the independent research company, *The Learning* Bar) to gain feedback on what our students think about school life. The survey typically takes 30 minutes, individual students are not able to be identified and it is only for students in Years 4-6. Participation in the survey is entirely voluntary. Your child will not take part if either you or your child do not wish. If uncomfortable during the survey, they can choose to stop at any time. If you do not wish your child to sit the survey please email the office before 1 April.

### Invoices

Invoices are being sent home today. You will notice that the voluntary contributions is a little different between siblings. This is because the contribution for one child is \$40 and for a family is \$60. Therefore, the first child (or families that only have one child at our school) has \$40, but then the second child will have \$20 (the remaining amount from the \$60 family contribution) and any other siblings will not have voluntary contributions down at all. Please remember this is voluntary and these funds will be going towards library books and STEM resources.

We realise volunteers would have done this last year, however, the form has to be filled out annually. 


### **Ethics Teachers Needed**
