Cross Country

To get to this point has taken many meetings and input from our community, the P&C and the school. Thank you to those on the P&C who have been involved in this process for a number of years now.

Differing Events

At the P&C meeting the inconsistencies between events, and indeed schools, was raised so I will try and clarify this further. I am aware that many schools are not having any spectators at their Easter Hat Parade, some are having limited numbers and others may be inviting a parent for each student. Generally this is based on how the school can best implement aspects of the required Covid Safety Plan. The requirements relating to people capacity in the specified area and procedures to ensure physical distancing, limiting congestion and

co-mingling are the ones that will differ for each school and each event.

We were able to do this for those invited to attend the Easter Hat Parade as it is a seated event (ensuring physical distancing and limited mingling), spread across multiple areas with sign on locations that are scattered. For other events, such as the cross country, there is not the same level of being able to abide by those requirements.
